ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the nonprofit laws of the State of Washington, RCW 24.03, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be: <u>PORT TOWNSEND PUBLIC</u> LIBRARY FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE II.

The term of existence shall be Perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

The purpose of this corporation shall be to provide for services and facilities over and above those which are financed by the traditional tax base funding of the Port Townsend Public Library.

The Port Townsend Public Library Foundation shall provide goods and services which include but are not limited to the following: books and other library materials, buildings, facilities, equipment, monies, endowment funds, and/or other real and personal property; or grants for any such purposes.

Under no circumstances shall Port Townsend Public Library

Foundation funds be used to substitute for traditional tax base funding of the Port Townsend Public Library.

ARTICLE IV.

The name of the Registered Agent of the corporation is CHERYL SILVERBLATT.

Amendments to Articles of Incorporation

May 24, 1995

Addendum to Article III.

"This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

"Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)."

"Upon winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, and or scientific purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

Addendum to Article VI.

"However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or no longer a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this organization shall be distributed to a fund, foundation, or organization which is organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code."
